The Chief General Manager (Gen), APGCL hereby, invites sealed offline Bids from eligible Govt. Registered Valuers following single-stage single envelope system of bidding "To carry out Valuation of the Scrap items lying at Dhansiri Hydroelectric Project, Bhairabkunda of APGCL".

- i. Open Competitive Bidding method shall be followed for selection of most preferred bidder for the tendered work.
- ii. The Bidding Documents can be downloaded by any prospective bidders from the APGCL website (www.apgcl.org) free of cost.

1. Eligibility of the Bidder:

The bidder should be a Govt. Registered valuer.

2. Experience of the Bidder:

The bidder must have experience of carrying out valuation of assets in similar Govt. / PSU Organizations viz. Power Generation Company (GENCO), Power Industry, Oil & Gas Industry etc.

1. The bidder shall visit the station and discussion with technical persons and to collect salient features of the station.
2. Detailed inspection is to be done of the unidentified items being kept in wooden box .
3. Preparation of Asset list individually with details of Make, model, year of manufacturing, Sl. No., Capacity etc.
4. Under indexation method, in the report - columns should show Gross as per BS, Pre-Opp expenses/IDC then NET and then the revaluation should be shown. Index factors must be shown in the working sheet.
5. For Imported Machinery, proper method should be applied.
6. Before finalisation DRAFT report must be shared with APGCL.
7. Discussion on Draft Valuation report
8. Submission of Final Valuation report

7. Terms and Conditions:

Firm Price:

The price(s) quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of GST and any other taxes and duties and shall be firm and without any variation in any way till completion of the work in full.

The basic price quoted by the bidder shall be inclusive of travelling expenses of Contractor's Personnel, boarding & lodging of Contractor's Personnel at site.

Accommodation with maximum two double-bedded rooms can be arranged on Chargeable basis for contractor's engineers/officers.

8. Evaluation and Comparison of Bid:

The Bid Evaluation Committee of the Procuring Entity for Evaluation of this Bid shall use the eligibility criteria given in this document.

The L1 bidder shall be selected based on the lowest total price offered (i.e. price inclusive of GST and any other tax and duties) subject to fulfillment of Eligibility and Experience Criteria given in this document.

9. Clarification and Additional Information:

During the submitted bid's evaluation, APGCL may request the bidder for any clarification on the submitted bid and/or documents related to the tender. The bidder shall submit the sought clarifications and/or document(s) within stipulated time as determined by the undersigned.

However, seeking clarification and document(s) during bid evaluation shall be on sole discretion of APGCL.

10. Settlement of Disputes:

a. Amicable Settlement:

If any dispute or difference (s) of any kind whatsoever arise between the parties in connection with or arising out of the work/contract, including without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, any question regarding its existence, validity or termination, or the execution of the Contract whether during the progress of the Contract or after its completion and whether before or after the termination, abandonment or breach of the Contract, the parties shall seek to resolve any such disputes or differences by mutual consultation between the authorized representatives of both the parties for amicable settlement of the dispute within a period of ninety (90) days after receipt by one party of the other party's request for such amicable settlement.

b. Arbitration:

Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this work/contract or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, that cannot be settled amicably between both the parties shall be settled by Arbitration.

In any arbitration proceeding hereunder-

- i. Arbitration shall be in accordance with the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory amendment thereof.
- ii. Arbitration shall be by a sole arbitrator, if agreed upon by the Parties. Failing agreement on the identity of such sole arbitrator, each Party shall appoint one arbitrator, and these two appointed arbitrators shall jointly appoint a third arbitrator, who shall chair the arbitration panel and act as the Presiding Arbitrator.
- iii. In an arbitration proceeding consisting of three arbitrators, if a party fails to appoint an arbitrator within 30 days from the receipt of a request to do so from the other party; or the two appointed arbitrators fail to agree on the third arbitrator within thirty days from the date of their appointment, the appointment shall be made upon request of a party by the High Court or by the President, Institution of Engineers (India), Assam State Centre.
- iv. In an arbitration with sole arbitrator, if the parties fail to agree on the arbitrator within 30 days from receipt of a request by one party from the other party to so agree, the appointment shall be made, upon request of a party, by the High Court or by the President, Institution of Engineers (India), Assam State Centre.
- v. Proceedings shall, unless otherwise agreed by the Parties, be held in Guwahati.
- vi. English language shall be the official language for all purposes.
- vii. Decision of the sole arbitrator or of a majority of the arbitrators (or of the third arbitrator if there is no such majority) and the Arbitral Award shall be final and binding on the parties and the persons claiming under them respectively and shall be enforceable in any court of competent jurisdiction, and the Parties hereby waive any objections to or claims of immunity in respect of such enforcement.
- viii. The arbitrators and the parties to the arbitration shall maintain confidentiality of all arbitral proceedings except award where its disclosure is necessary for the purpose of implementation, enforcement and setting aside of the award.
- ix. The cost of arbitration shall be equally shared among both the parties.

11. Legal Jurisdiction:

Any disputes or differences arising under, out of, or in connection with this work/contract, shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Guwahati only.

12. Terms of Payment:

100% payment of the total order value (including GST etc.) shall be made after successful completion of the entire work subject to submission and acceptance of the Valuation Report by APGCL.

13. Work Completion Period:

The Work Completion Period for the entire work shall be 90 (Ninety) days from the date of issue of formal Work Order. However, the successful bidder shall have to submit a weekly report on evaluation activities to the Chief General Manager (Gen) APGCL without failure.

14. Liquidated Damage (LD):

The date of completion of work shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and shall be completed not later than the date specified in the contract. In case of failure to complete the work in full or to complete the work within the stipulated completion schedule, the Purchaser/Employer shall be entitled to: -

- Recover an amount at the rate of 1 % (one Percent) of the Contract Price per week or part thereof of delay, subject to maximum of 10 % (ten percent) of the contract price as liquidated damage to APGCL. However, the payment of liquidated damages shall not in any way relieve the Contractor from any obligations to complete the works or from any other obligations and liabilities of the Contractor under the Contract.
- Complete the balance work, giving notice to the Contractor and to recover any extra expenditure incurred thereby for having to complete the work at a higher price, at risk and responsibility of the Contractor.
- Cancel the Contract/Work Order wholly or in part and execute the work at the full risk and cost of the Contractor and forfeit the security deposit.
